Introduction-

 Cleaning and disinfecting is important to maintain the well being and health of high producing animals, such as dairy cows.

- 2. This is especially the case in intensive modern housing where high density and high productivity increases the the infection pressure.
- 3. Thorough cleaning and disinfection decreases the pathogen level and prevents or breaks the disease cycle.
- Disinfectant will not clean dirt and all organic material including bedding and dried manure must be removed prior to disinfection.
- 5. This means the walls and floor should be washed thoroughly with soap and water and allowed to dry prior to the application of a disinfectant.

Objectives-

- 1. Frequent cleaning and disinfection helps to prevent the spread of germs that may causes illness.
- Cleaning is an important first step because it physically removes dirt, organic matter and most of germs from surface.
- 3. The proper use of medical disinfectants can help to prevent the spread of harmful bacteria and worms.
- 4. It is necessary to keep animals healthy and disease free.

Planning-

- First of all I discussed with my concerned course teacher for the conduction of this demonstration.
- 2. Then I collected all the required information related to the demonstration.
- 3. I fixed the date, time and place for the conduction of demonstration.
- 4. I also discussed with Mr.Bhanudas Nale.
- 5. Regarding to conduction of demonstration, I collected the required material for actual conduction of demonstration.
- 6. Then I gave invitation to all farmers.

7. displayed the notice on grampanchayat board to invite maximum number of peoples to attend the demonstration.

Conduction-

- 1. I along with farmers gathered together as per fixed date, time and place.
- 2. Firstly I old all information about demonstration and its importance.
- 3. Then I started actual process of demonstration as follows-
- 4. Firstly I removed the excessive food waste, grasses and other solid material with the help of broom.
- 5. Then with the help of spade, I cleaned the dung on the surface, collected it in a ghamela and put it in backyard. After that with the use of pipe, broom and detergent, I washed the animals and cleaned the floor.
- 6. Then I sprayed the disinfectant solution on the floor with the help of knapsack sprayer.
- 7. The precaution should be taken that disinfectant was not sprayed on the animal body.
- 8. At last I removed the excessive disinfectant and moisture, made the shelter dry and clean.

Questions asked by farmers-

1. Why cleaning and disinfection is important?

-To prevent harmful diseases from germs to come in contact with cattles.

2. Which machine is used for cleaning of shed and animals?

-The machine known as animal cleaning pump or dairy dung pump is used.

3. What are the various after care practices?

-Try to maintain dry floor. Bedding material should br sprayed on the floor. It helps to soak the urine and avoids the slippering of animals.

4.It is necessary to wear mask and gloves while cleaning and disinfection?

-Yes, it is important; it is helpful to maintain human health, to avoid any pathogen and germ to inject.

Farmer's reaction-

- 1. Before this demo, the farmers were doing the cleaning practice as indigenous way from older times.
- 2. Now with the help pf this demonstration they were able to understand the importance of the cleaning and disinfection.
- 3. Farmers were satisfied because it gives them ideas for the correct method of cleaning and disinfection of shed.
